

ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

SMRH Workshop program on "Enhancing Sustainability Management Research Writing in Egypt"

The "Enhancing Sustainability Management Research in Egypt" workshop program aims to equip early career researchers from Egypt with the skills and knowledge to conduct high-quality research on sustainability management. Through a series of in-country and online workshops, Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs), and personalized mentoring sessions over two years, participants will gain expertise in qualitative and quantitative research methodologies, develop academic writing skills, and learn to navigate publishing in international journals. The program will foster a network of sustainability management researchers, facilitating collaboration and knowledge exchange to address pressing sustainable development challenges.

This workshop program is generously funded by the British Academy under the International Writing Workshops scheme. The program represents a collaborative effort between Roehampton University (UK), The Egyptian E-learning University, and Coventry University branch in Egypt.

1. Program overview

The "Enhancing Sustainability Management Research in Egypt" program is a comprehensive two-year initiative designed to empower early career researchers in sustainability management. It consists of four intensive modules, complemented by online sessions and personalized mentoring. Participants will develop crucial skills in qualitative and quantitative research methods, academic writing, and publishing in international journals. The program covers key areas such as social research foundations, sustainability concepts, and effective academic communication. By combining in-person workshops, virtual learning, and one-on-one guidance, the program aims to create a vibrant community of researchers equipped to address Egypt's pressing sustainability challenges through high-quality research and international collaboration.











2. Workshops Content and Methodology

The workshop series consists of four intensive modules spread over two years, combining inperson and online learning:

Module 1: Foundations of Social Research and Effective Academic Writing	Module 2: Qualitative Research Methods

The program involves a blend of interactive workshops, practical sessions, and peer review activities. Participants engage in lectures, group discussions, and hands-on exercises to deepen their understanding. Practical sessions focus on research software and tools, while peer review activities enhance critical thinking and writing skills. One-on-one mentoring with experienced researchers provides personalized guidance. Additionally, online learning modules and resources support self-paced study, and virtual networking events help build a community of sustainability researcher.

Participants will work on their own research projects throughout the program, applying learned concepts and receiving feedback from mentors and peers. The program culminates in a virtual conference where participants present their research findings.

4. Who can apply? (Selection Criteria, Participants' Profile)

Up to 25 participants will be selected

Participants' Profile

- Early-career researchers (within five years of their Ph.D.), PhD or master's students
- English language skills (speaking and writing)
- Commitment to
 - o attend all workshops, feedback meeting to develop their research project,
 - Report every three months on their research progress
- Minimum technical equipment that guarantees the regular contact during the online phases.











Selection criteria

The selection criteria are based on the following:

- Research interest match
- Quality of research proposal
- · Professional background

A gender balance is aimed at, given that qualifications and other criteria are fulfilled.

5. Funding and Cost

This program is fully funded by the British Academy. This will cover the following expenses during the presence (i.e., face to face) workshops:

- Accommodation for participants resident outside Cairo
- Refreshments and meals (usually lunch)
- Workshop materials
- Child care support is available for participants with childcare responsibilities
